Things to Consider When Applying Early Action or Early Decision:

- Know the difference between Early Action and Early Decision
 - See the NACAC Table on the next page
- You are confident about your GPA and test scores at the time of your initial application.
- You have visited the college campus and the school is a great fit for you, particularly if you are applying early decision.
- Your testing will be completed by October.
- Your first quarter grades are strong. They may be requested

Early Decision...Is it for me?

An Early Decision Admission is binding, if you are admitted you must attend.

Are you unsure if it is the right decision for you?

Take the quiz below to see if you are a strong candidate for early decision. Then, talk to your parents and your counselor for further advice before making your final decision.

1. Is there a college you REALLY like? Yes or No

If your answer is yes, then continue.



If your answer is No, Stop here. You are definitely not ready to apply early anywhere

2. Is there a SINGLE college you like more than any other college? Yes or No

If Yes, Continue.



If your answer is No, Stop here. You are not ready to apply early.

3. Have you visited the college you like more than any other college? Yes or No

If Yes, Continue.



If your answer is No, Stop here. You are not ready to apply early.

If you have answered yes to each of the above questions, then you may be a good candidate for applying early decision.

Discuss the early decision process with your counselor, as well as your parents.
