DONATIONS:

- **Toberman Neighborhood Center: March 8-19, 2010**
CHOOSE **ONE:** Fill bag with dollar value of \$8 to \$10
 1. **SCHOOL KIT** (include any: youth scissors, pencils, erasers, notebook paper) Value \$8-\$10
 2. **CRADLE CLOSET** (include any: disposable diapers-any size; baby wipes, gently-used or new baby clothes) Value \$8 to \$10
 3. **FOOD PANTRY** (include any: pop-top canned tuna; graham crackers; peanut butter; dried beans, dried rice) Value \$ 8 to \$10

PLEASE: ONLY **NEW FOOD ITEMS; NO EXPIRED ITEMS OR OLD FOOD.**

Expired or old food items will be turned away.

Bring the donations to the school library. Identify with student name and grade for credit

PLEASE: new items only for donations (except if donating "gently-used" baby clothes)

Bring items to library, clearly marked with student's name and grade level.

Do not bring before March 8.
