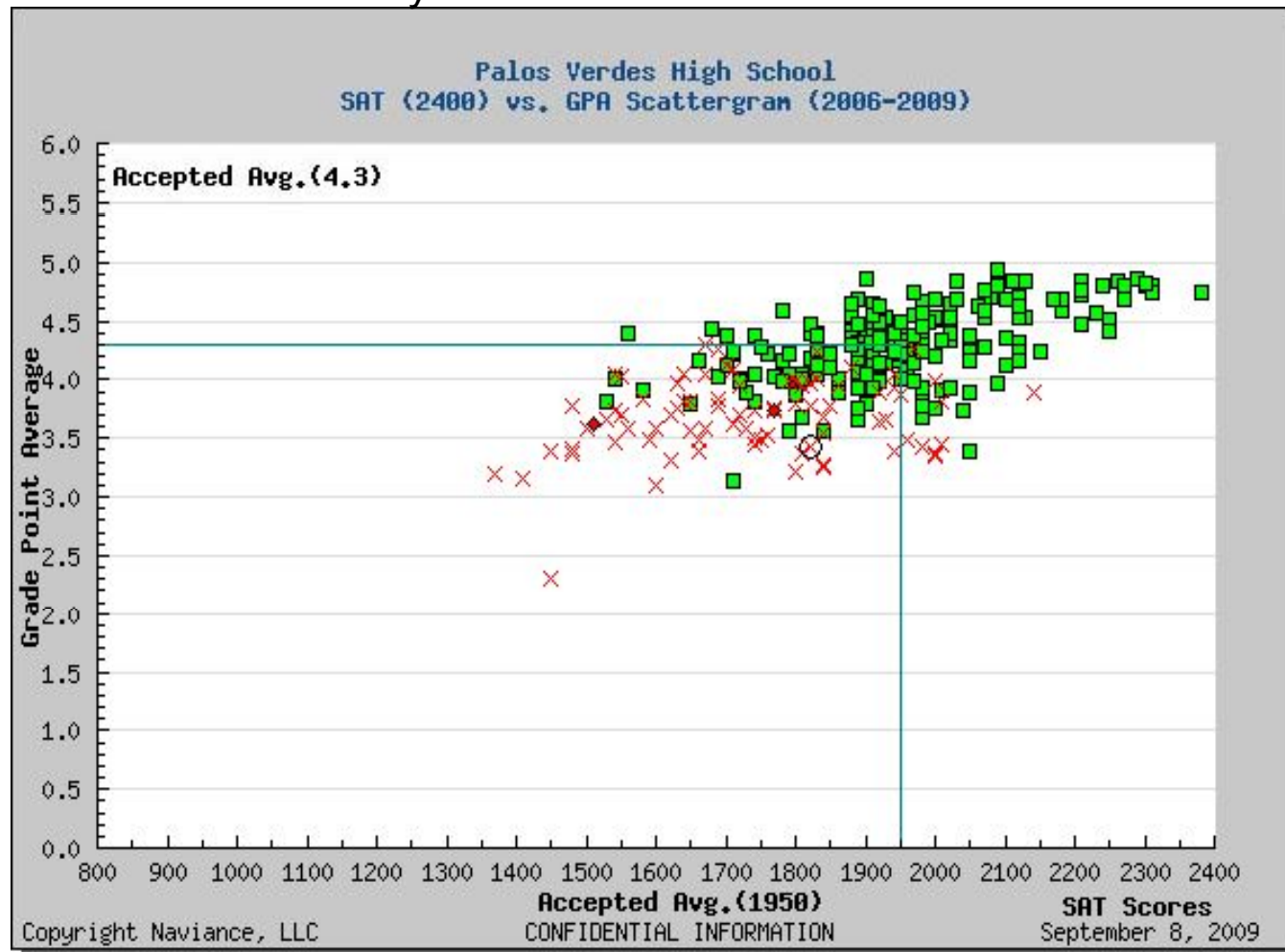

# Developing Your College List

- List should be a good balance of Reach, Target and Likely
- Research, Research, Research!
- Use Advanced College Search on Naviance
- College search books and websites
- Visit schools this summer
  - Try virtual tours
  - Visit schools in our local area

# Looking for your college match...

- Know yourself...Identify priorities for you and your family
  - Look for schools that match your strengths and learning style
    - Location, Location, Location
      - Research!
      - Visit colleges
    - Be realistic and maintain perspective
- Remember, 82% of all colleges accept more than 50% of the students who apply to them, according to the National Association for College Admission Counseling.



# College Visits at PVHS

- Over 100 college admission officers visit PVHS each fall
- Excellent opportunity to make connections
- Gain insight into these campuses
- Often the reader of your application

# Essays and Personal Statements

- It should be in your own voice
- Your essay shouldn't be coached
- Opportunity to display knowledge of a particular school
- Discuss why you are a fit for that school
- If there are short answer questions, DO NOT leave them blank.
- Complete any "optional" essays!
- Do not submit an essay you wrote for class

# Admissions Options



- Restrictive Application Plans
  - Early Decision: Binding commitment, only one school
  - Restrictive Early Action: Non-binding, only one school
- Non-Restrictive Application Plans
  - Regular Decision: submit application by a specified date and receive a decision within a stated period of time
  - Rolling Admission: applications are reviewed as they are completed and decisions are sent to students throughout admissions cycle
  - Early Action: students apply early and receive a decision in advance of the regular response date

- If you plan on playing D1 or D2 sports, Register Now!
- Send a transcript at the end of junior year
- Develop an athletic resume
- For D1: Must meet 16 core course requirement
- For D2: Must meet 14 core course requirement

# Letters of Recommendation

- Teacher Letter

- Purpose: Spotlight accomplishments within the scope of the classroom
- Ask a teacher who knows you well
- Preferably academic teacher from junior year
- Check college for specific requirements
- Give teacher at least two weeks before due date
- Be Organized!
- Send a thank you card!



# Letters of Recommendation

- Counselor Letter:
  - Purpose: Overall picture of student
  - Complete Senior Letter of Recommendation Packet on Naviance thoroughly and clearly.
  - Reminder: UC and CSU campuses do not accept letters of recommendation
  - Deadline to ask for letters of recommendation from teachers and counselors:
    - Early Admission: September 30, 2011
    - Regular Admission: November 4, 2011
