How to get into Tri-M

- Love music
- Participate in music department: be in a music class and do volunteer work for the department
- Be at least a sophomore
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Have a good attitude, be responsible, and communicate well with others
- Submit a Tri-M application to Ms. Parkinson or the presidents by the given deadline
 - Final decisions on Tri-M membership are made by Ms. Parkinson

How to stay in Tri-M

- Complete the minimum service hours (10 per semester)
- Be active on at least one committee
- Have a good participation grade in music class/Maintain good citizenship in music class
- Maintain the minimum GPA
- Attend all meetings unless excused (Excused = you are sick or otherwise absent from school, or you have notified a board member or Ms. Parkinson with a valid excuse.)

Probation

- If you fail to meet these requirements, you will be placed on probation, which means you will be dismissed from Tri-M if:
 - you miss another meeting without valid reason
 - you fail to complete the minimum service hours for both semesters
 - you do not meet the minimum GPA on your next report card
 - you do not improve your music class citizenship/participation
 - you are consistently inactive in your committee
- To be removed from probation for missing meetings or incomplete service hours, you will be reinstated when you complete an additional two service hours for the semester (12 a semester).
- To be removed from probation for failing to meet the grade requirements, you must meet the requirements on your next report card
- If you are dismissed from Tri-M, you will be ineligible for readmittance for one full semester. After this time, you may submit a Tri-M membership application to Ms. Parkinson for review.
