Tardies

Habitual tardiness becomes an attendance problem subject to disciplinary action. A student will be marked tardy if he/she arrives to class up to 10 minutes after the bell rings without appropriate permission from the office.

Cut/Truancy

Cutting, whether single period or full-day, is considered an unexcused absence. Students with more than 4 cuts in one semester per class may be dropped from the class. **NO MAKE UP WORK IS PERMITTED FOR STUDENTS WHEN THEY CUT CLASS**.

Cut - If a student is more than 10 minutes late to a class without appropriate permission from the office.

Truancy – If a student misses 3 or more periods in a school day without appropriate permission or prior clearance from the Attendance Office.
